

Area 32 District 8: Service Position Descriptions

PI/CPC Coordinator · Public Info. and Cooperation with Prof. Communities

The PI/CPC Coordinator coordinates and oversees all outreach efforts to carry the message of Al-Anon to the community including but not limited to: general public, doctors, attorneys, counsellors, law enforcement, libraries, shelters, non-profits, and churches. The time commitment varies in hours/month. The term is 2 years. Prerequisite for the position is: 2 years of active Al-Anon recovery.

Duties include:

- 1. Attend monthly District meetings and submit a written report to the Secretary
- 2. Submit accurate information to and periodically review community calendars
- 3. Work with WSO and local TV/radio stations to distribute PSAs
- 4. Order and stock pamphlets and meeting schedules in racks around the community
- 5. Maintain a list of locations where pamphlets are accepted and distributed
- 6. Make contacts with professionals and establish a working relationship as a point-of-contact for them and those they serve
- 7. Report to Area 32 Coordinator and assist with Area projects, as needed
- 8. Coordinate with Gallatin County Alcohol and Drug Services to schedule speakers
- 9. Review the PI/CPC binder to familiarize yourself with past projects and maintain records of current outreach efforts
- 10. Request a PI/CPC budget as part of the District annual budget
- 11. Submit expenses for reimbursement in keeping with the Group Conscience
- 12. Brainstorm and propose new and creative outreach efforts
